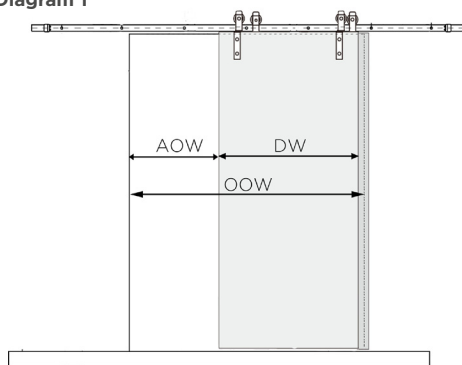
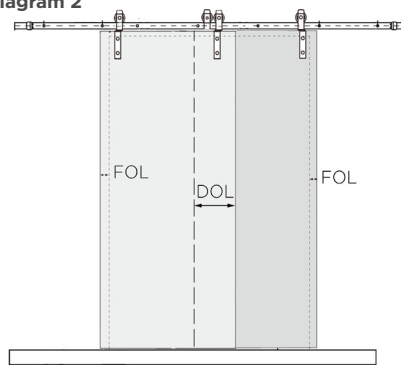

Calculation

$$\text{OOW} = (\text{DW} \times 2) - 250$$

$$\text{AOW} = \text{DW} - 281$$
